Sonus Instrument Repair

Woodwind Reed Cleaning

You need:

- Toothbrush (old one!)
- Dishwashing liquid
- · Paper Towels
- Hydrogen Peroxide
- Small bottle/container (old, empty medicine bottle is good)

Take the reed out of the holder.

Wet it with warm water

Put a SMALL amount of detergent on it.

Gently scrub front & back with the toothbrush

RINSE THOROUGHLY

Dry with paper towel

Pour hydrogen peroxide into container; enough to cover at least half of the reed.

Dip the reed into the H2O2 & take it out ...watch it bubble!

RINSE again; repeat the dipping process until the bubbles stop; rinse & dry each time.

After last rinse, place the reed back in the reed holder.
